Note: ^{a)} In France Louis was a farmer. He was a soldier in the French Army for fourteen years during which time he served in the Italian and Austrian wars of the fifties, as well as having served in the French army in Africa for four years. Louis came to America in 1865. Following that, he located in Dekalb County, Illinois, where he engaged in farming until 1872, when he came to Wright County, Iowa. Here he bought eighty acres of land in Woolstock township, a place which Mr. Kastler developed from raw prairie to a well improved and highly cultivated farm of five hundred and eighty acres.

Louis and his wife Mary Louise Muller were members of the French Lutheran Church.
